

4 Year College Timeline and Checklist

<u>September – November 2020</u>

- ✓ Start off the year by double-checking that you're meeting all of your A-G College Admissions requirements (by the end of your senior year).
- ✓ Finalize your college list.
- ✓ Now that you have an idea of where you want to go, visit prospective colleges (virtually) and get a feel for the campuses.
 - Attend COLLEGE QUEST 2020 by going to <u>https://collegeoptions.org/college_quest/</u>. College Quest 2020 is a virtual college fair and information night. It will take place on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 from 5:00 to 7:30 pm. (A link to the presentation will be added closer to the event)
 - Financial Aid Presentation will be held from 5:30 6:30pm.
 - **Chico State University -** will be hosting a live virtual high school visit on <u>Friday Oct. 16th at</u> <u>11am-noon</u>. More information will be coming as the date gets closer.
 - **UC Santa Barbara -** will be hosting a live virtual high school visit on <u>Thursday, Oct. 22 at</u> <u>3:00-3:45pm</u>. Click <u>here</u> to register!

- ✓ Request letters of recommendations from teachers, facilitators, high school counselor, etc.
- Start working on your Personal Insight Questions (UC's); it's a crucial part of your application.

- ✓ Register for SAT or ACT <u>no later than Dec. 7th</u> by going to <u>https://www.collegeboard.org/</u>.
 - CSU has temporarily suspended the use of ACT/SAT examination in determining admissions eligibility for all CSU campuses for the 2021-2022 academic year. This change applies only for the fall 2021, winter 2022, and spring 2022 admission cycle. For more information, click <u>here</u>
 - UC will be "test-optional" for the fall 2021 and fall 2022. Freshman applicants are not required to submit SAT/ACT scores. For more information, click <u>here</u>.
 - You choose whether or not to submit SAT/ACT scores with your application
 - If you are unable or choose not to submit test scores, your application will still receive full consideration.
- ✓ Start working on your Fall 2021 UC application now by clicking <u>here</u>.

- ✓ Application deadline dates:
 - <u>University of California</u> November 1st November 31st
 - o California State University -October 1st December 4th
 - Private and Out of State Colleges (Common App) Varies by college
- ✓ Explore your prospective colleges' financial aid requirements to plan your college budget.
- \checkmark Complete the <u>FAFSA</u> so you can get the most possible financial assistance for college.
 - $\circ \quad October \ 1^{st} \ 2020 March \ 2^{nd} \ 2021$

December - February

- Continue your hunt for scholarships and apply for scholarships. *For a list of local scholarships, go to <u>www.shastacharteracademy.org</u> College and Career Scholarships
- ✓ Complete your FAFSA so you can get the most possible financial assistance for college!!

Timeframe: October 1st – March 2nd. FAFSA

March - May

- ✓ Once you've received all of your responses from colleges, make your final decision!
- ✓ Verify your financial aid before you make any college budget decisions.
- ✓ Send your final transcripts to your college and meet housing deadlines. (Our registrar will send your transcripts to your college).
- ✓ Cross everything off your graduation checklist and graduate!
